

HOW WE DELIVER OUR PROGRAMMES

Our live induction training is delivered remotely by a care experienced tutor directly to your teams. These live webinar workshops are fully interactive and provide the opportunity for staff to raise questions or concerns they may have. The workshops are provided flexibly to fit in with employer's needs, and we also provide the opportunity for individuals after the event to contact our help desk support team for additional guidance if necessary relating to the topics covered.

The webinar workshop duration for each presentation topic is normally designed to last 1 hour. A rapid induction programme has been designed for individuals wishing to cover all the Care Certificate knowledge requirements, as one programme. This is delivered over 11 x 1 hour sessions within 3 days.





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The live webinar workshops are recorded, and links are given to access these where individuals are unable to attend the workshop.

Following the workshop, all attendees are given access to a free high quality full care certificate e-learning course covering the topic of the presentation. They will be able to access this at any time for a further 364 days, which provides an excellent opportunity to refresh on the topic at any time in this period. This enables a structured approach and following input from your employer, you will be issued with a copy of the Care Certificate when completed.

In addition to the tutor led webinar workshops and e-learning, our offer includes

- Tutor help desk during office hours telephone/email
- Access to QCS sector leading operational resources relevant to topics.
- Access to our managed social media peer group established for these programmes
- Employer support workshop access for advice and guidance on induction matters
- Certificates issued for those attending any programme


